**SUPPLEMENT TO CLASS REPRESENTATIVE'S MOTION FOR FINAL
APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT**

Class Representative Kristina Stacy Kawulok ("Class Representative") submits this Supplement to Class Representative's Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Final Approval Motion"), which was filed on May 11, 2026. As is common, Class Representative's Final Approval Motion was due prior to the request for exclusion and objection deadline (May 19, 2026). As a result, Class Representative submits this supplement to address objections (**none**) and requests for exclusions (**one**).

1. Objections

Class Representative is pleased to report that there were no objections to the Settlement, Settlement Agreement, or the requests for Plaintiff's Attorneys' Fees, Litigation Expenses, Administration, Notice, and Distribution Costs, or the Case Contribution Award, as of the objection deadline (May 19, 2026), nor have any objections been received as of the time of this filing.

2. Requests for Exclusion

Out of the over 5,200 potential Class Members, only one (1) request for exclusion was submitted. Class Representative provides the chart attached as **Exhibit 1** to detail that request.


The submitted request for exclusion represents merely **0.0462%** of the Net Settlement Fund under the Initial Plan of Allocation. In other words, over **99.95%** of the value of Class Member claims have chosen to participate in and support the Settlement. With respect to approving a class action settlement, the Tenth Circuit has held that a district court did not abuse its discretion in approving a class settlement from which an “extremely small percentage of class members opted out.” *Rutter & Wilbanks Corp. v. Shell Oil Co.*, 314 F.3d 1180, 1188 (10th Cir. 2002).

Class Representative recommends approving the request for exclusion detailed in **Exhibit 1** at the Final Fairness Hearing on June 9, 2026.

Conclusion

In short, the information necessary for Class Members to consider their options under the Settlement has been provided in accordance with the Court’s Preliminary Approval Order and the Notices. There have been no objections and only one (1) request for exclusion. Class Representative respectfully requests that the Court approve the Settlement and grant the final approval motions, updated versions of which Class Counsel will provide to the Court at the Final Fairness Hearing.


